Open your web browser (e.g., Safari) and go to the website <https://go.fau.de/1bi-h>.

 To use some profiles under iOS, iPadOS and visionOS, a [Unlock code](#) be set up!

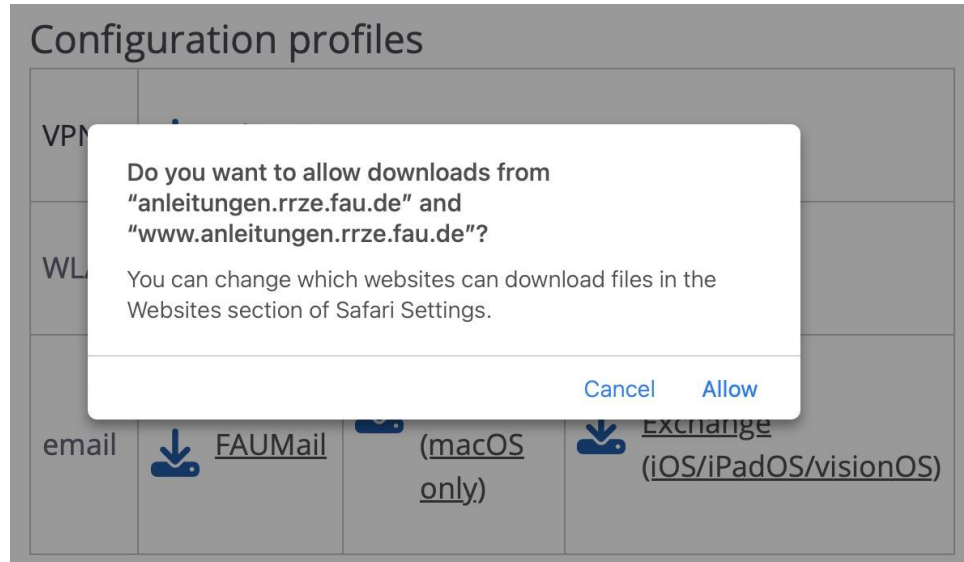
Select the eduroam configuration profile to download it.

To be able to apply configuration profiles, a [password](#) must be set up on your iMac or MacBook.

During some steps, you will be prompted to enter your password. For the sake of clarity, this is not described further in the instructions.

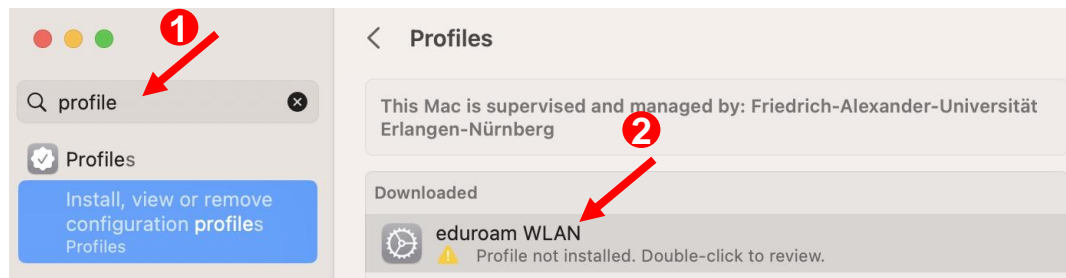

Click "Allow" to download the configuration profile.

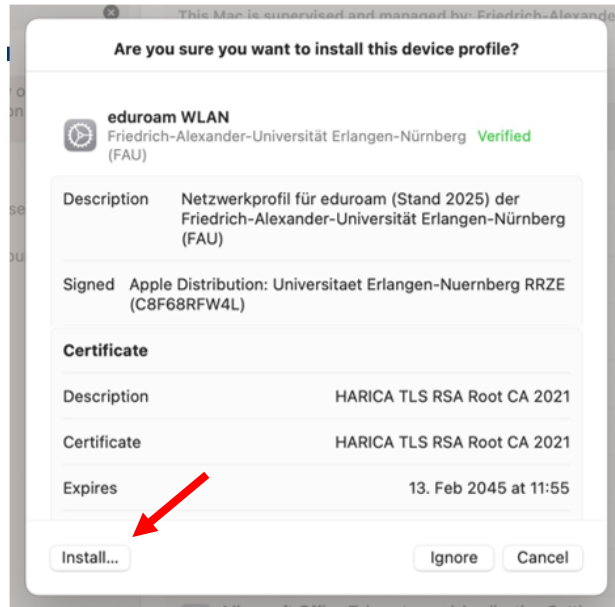
Then open the settings and type "profile" (1) in the search bar.

Next, go to "Install, view, or remove configuration profiles" and click on "eduroam WLAN" (2).

eduroam Setup

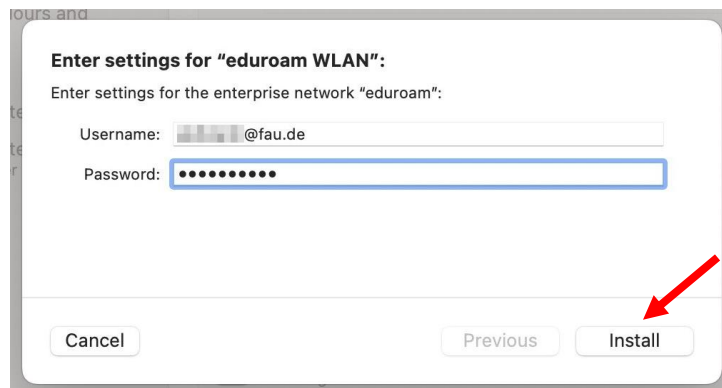


When prompted with “Are you sure you want to install this device profile?”, click "Install".

A second prompt will appear — "Really install device profile?" (no screenshot) — please confirm this by clicking "Continue".

Then, in the next screen, log in using your IdM username followed by @fau.de and your corresponding password.

(example: ab12cdef@fau.de)



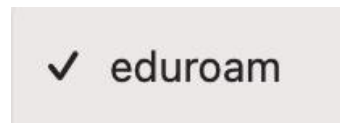
A new window titled "Profile eduroam WLAN" will appear (not shown in the screenshot) — please confirm by clicking "Install".

This completes the installation of the configuration profile.
It will now appear in the settings under "Configuration Profiles".

You can now connect to the "eduroam" Wi-Fi network.

Go to Wi-Fi in the settings and select "eduroam" on the right side.

Then log in using your IdM username followed by @fau.de and your corresponding password.
